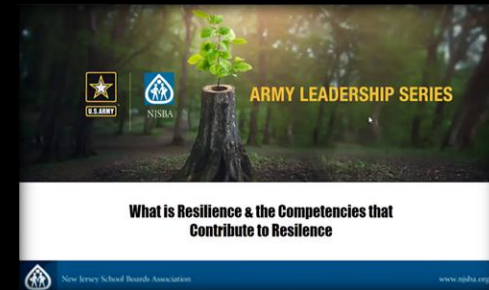
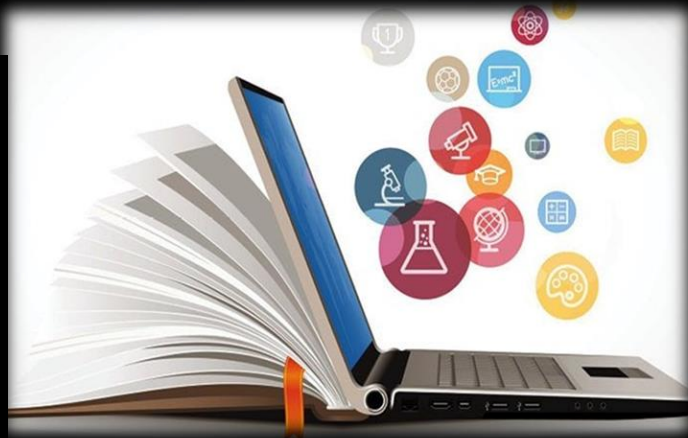

National Defense Science and Engineering Graduate (NDSEG) Fellowship

For those pursuing a doctoral degree in a STEM discipline, the National Defense Science and Engineering Graduate (NDSEG) fellowship confers high honors upon its recipients, and allows them to attend whichever U.S. institution they choose. NDSEG Fellowships last for three years and pay for full tuition and all mandatory fees, a monthly stipend and up to \$1,000 a year in medical insurance (this excludes dental and vision insurance). **LEARN MORE**

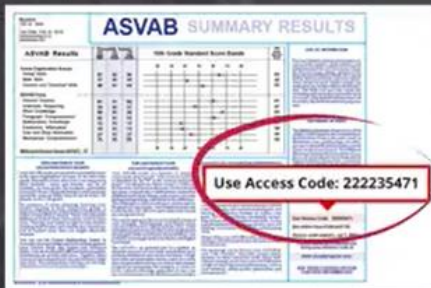

Session Overview

TOPIC

Use of the Federally-funded ASVAB CEP continues to increase with over 3.4M students participating in the last five years! The ASVAB is used for career exploration, military entrance, and classification. Some states also use the ASVAB as a graduation requirement (a free option for your students). But, it's not just a military test! The ASVAB is only one part of the ASVAB CEP. Isn't it time you learned more about all of the ASVAB CEP components?

CONTENT AREA

Career Development and Counseling: The ASVAB CEP consists of several main components - the ASVAB, an interest inventory based on John Holland's RIASEC codes called Find Your Interests (FYI), and career exploration via the OCCU-Find, classroom activities, and CareersintheMilitary.com.

Session Objectives

- Differentiate between the different components of the ASVAB CEP.
- Identify the two missions of the ASVAB CEP.
- Explain the general function and predictive ability of the ASVAB.
- Articulate how the ASVAB fits into the ASVAB CEP.
- Explain how Holland's RIASEC types help students with career exploration.
- Articulate how the Find Your Interests (FYI) functions and why it uses gender-based reporting.
- Explain how the results of the ASVAB and FYI can be used in the OCCU-Find to provide the basis of meaningful career exploration.
- Lists sources of OCCU-Find job data and how it's used to inform career planning.
- Describe personalized career planning tools.
- Identify different user groups who can benefit from Careers in the Military.
- Prepare students to conduct informed research on military options and seek out recruiters.

Army Leadership & Resilience Webinar Series

Based on the U.S. Army Master Resilience Trainer course, the seven-part series will provide an overview of positive core competencies that contribute to resilience and strong leadership. Topics to be discussed include problem solving, goal setting, finding positivity, countering negative biases, promoting collaboration, and identifying emotion-based core beliefs and values that can trigger catastrophic thinking.

Goal Setting, May 18: Identify, plan for and commit to the pursuit of a goal that results in more optimal performance, sustained motivation, and increased effort.

Hunt the Good Stuff, June 16: Counter the negativity bias, create positive emotions and refine your skills in noticing good things.

Avoid Thinking Traps, July 15: Identify and correct counterproductive patterns in thinking through the use of mental games and critical questions.

Problem Solving, August 19: Learn how to discover the cause of problems and deploy solution strategies.
